

My Story

I am one of twenty-two homeless children who live together in this rented home in Nepal. It is a concrete box with four small rooms.

We are a very happy home. We sing, laugh, play, eat and study together.

Our life was really hard before we met some Australians two years ago who have been helping us with school fees, clothing, food and medical care.

We are low caste children, at the bottom of the economic ladder.

Our Founder, Niwas, was himself an orphan from a low caste. He and his wife look after us with no help from the government .

Niwas collects rice, vegetables, and lentils from over twenty different donors in our local area, otherwise we would have nothing to eat.

We are happy living together. But now we have a problem because Nepali government officials say our

home is too small. We agree but cannot afford anything larger.
