“As you may know I have recently spent time volunteering for DHARMIK in Nepal. DHARMIK directly supports 3 orphanages in Kathmandu with education, food, medical supplies and milk for young babies. Larger projects are underway such as:

- ~ Providing physiotherapy for children/adolescents with physical disabilities;
- ~ Water filters and solar pumps for remote villages;
- ~ Developing a voluntourism project for Nepal’s largest orphanage, which houses over 600 children.”
