True to our promise we are improving our sponsor – child feedback this year! It has taken so long because we were really busy with very basic things last year. What's really exciting is we have had help from one aussie and seven Nepali volunteers to get the updated information for you.

Our first day was at the Sai Home. It was a public holiday so all the kids were at home.



We started with a simple meal and then had two teams of people working in parallel to train the children, interview the children and photograph them and samples of their school work and make a short video on a hand held camera.



The atmosphere was party like with much laughter and joy.





Naturally the normal daily work continued as you can see Bursa's sister washing the dishes, and the chickens, ducks and dog seemed oblivious to all the action.



We hope you enjoy this update. The children are really well and so happy. Your money is spent over the entire home and not on individual children. The twins are so happy in the home and get on well with the whole family.

The Sai Home was the first home we helped. When we met them their living conditions were extreme poverty. After addressing that we moved the girls to a better school last year and this year the boys will go to the same school. We are still seeking up to three sponsors for each child as this is the real cost of providing the basics in a reasonable local standard. We don't like to start anything with ongoing costs (like school fees) until we have the regular sponsor income to support that cost over the long term.



Next update we will focus on the each child's situation at school. Thank you for your continued support it makes a visible, factual, fantastic difference! Your support is

giving these children huge potential for their future lives. Your support is delivered in the context of local / international partnership and cooperation. Thank you again!
